

Broadway Loop (~240 mile)

A great ride that will take you through Western MD, North Eastern West Virginia and then south into the Lost River valley region of Virginia. It's a varied route, starting with a run through Mt. Storm (there's a reason it's so named!), into the panhandle of eastern WV with several lunch stop options available in Romney, WV. Your route will continue eastward before turning south into the Lost River region (offering another great lunch stop at the Lost River Grill). After the Lost River valley you'll head southeast through Broadway, VA, and eventually head west back into the mountains of West Virginia for your return to Canaan Valley.

- North on Rt. 32 to Davis
- Rt. 93 North to Rt. 42 towards Mt Storm
 - Viewpoint by lake on right (gravel)
- North on Rt. 42 to Rt. 50
 - Viewpoint Saddle Mountain (gravel)
- Rt. 50 east to Rt. 29
 - Keep right on 50E / 220 to Rt 29
 - Mario's Restaurant right at main intersection in Romney - S. High St.
 - or
 - Pass through Romney to Stray Cat Café
 - On left in shopping center
 - Continue Rt. 50E to Rt. 29
 - Liberty Gas – good prices at turn onto Rt. 29
- Rt. 29 south to Rt. 259
 - Lost River Grill – good lunch too <http://www.lostrivergrill.com/>
 - Lost River State Park turnoff
 - Pretty, (shaded and cool) road – 4 miles to Park
 - ALT ROUTE back available through Park
 - Goes to 220 at Moorefield
 - 17 miles, steep, paved (they say!)
 - Otherwise turn around and 4 miles back to 259
- Rt. 259 south to Rt. 42
 - **Shortcut Available**
 - Turn right onto 613 S before reaching 42
 - Go about 15 miles
 - Turn right onto 33W

- Rt. 42 South to Rt. 33
 - Rt. 33 West to Judy Gap
 - After Franklin Keep Left/Turn Left on 33W
 - **Alternate Route Available For Real Studs.**

 - Rt. 28 North to Seneca Rock
 - Rt. 33 West to Harmon
 - Rt. 32 North to Canaan Valley

Alternate Route From Franklin Through Seneca Rocks Rec Area

- Rt. 33 West to Judy Gap
 - ALTERNATE ROUTE AVAILABLE FOR REAL STUDS
 - NOTE – YOU CAN DO THIS LOOP ANYTIME
 - NOTE – IT IS BEST RUN South-North (E-W)
 - ALT - After Franklin Keep Right onto 220N
 - ALT – Go approximately 12 miles
 - ALT – Turn Left onto Smoke Hole Road
 - ALT – Follow through Seneca Rocks Rec Area
 - ALT – First section pretty, but poor road
 - Go SLOW here
 - ALT – After passing Store road gets better
 - ALT – Then road is GREAT!!
 - ALT – Exit at 28; go 28 SOUTH to Seneca Rock
 - ALT – Rejoin route at Seneca Rock and go Rt. 33 West to Harmon
